- OCould be divide in 4 section.
 - ① AB · · · Introduction. Without Lylics. One might imagine heavy steps due to the cross.
 - ② CDE · · · Include complicated choir such as that starting from the 31st bar
 - ③ FG···turning in major, reverie-like
 - 4 H · · · returning in minor
- OFor conversation between choir members e.g., who? how?who?how? and replys starting from the 26th bar, inquiries are to be played *sforzando* (with sudden emphasis) and a lag to represent a crowd.
- ○The last 90th bar is terminated with the major chord which is known as "Amen cadence" in the church music. *Arpeggio* (chord played in a rising order) for the left chord may evoke the majestic orchestra.
- OMinimum pedal signs are given. Step more frequently if you seek clearer sound.
